






Tarangire has one of the largest elephant populations in the country. During peak migration, from July to October, about 5,000 of these gentle giants migrate to Tarangire; sometimes groups of 300 elephants can be seen at a time. Lions, leopards and cheetahs are often seen patrolling the grasslands or perched in trees.

The Hadza, also known as Hadzabe, are an indigenous ethnic group living in the Lake Eyasi region of northern Tanzania. They are one of the last remaining huntergatherer tribes on the African continent. The Hadza have a unique way of life and culture that has attracted the attention of anthropologists and travellers. After activities with the Hadzabe, transfer to Rhino Lodge in Ngorongoro for dinner and overnight









Early in the morning, we will head to the Ngorongoro Crater for a full day game drive. As well as being the largest intact volcanic caldera on earth, the Ngorongoro Crater is also a natural sanctuary for some of the densest populations of large mammals in Africa. Due to its enclosed nature, the Ngorongoro Crater has effectively formed its own ecosystem. Later, after lunch, drive to the Serengeti, where you will spend the your night.









The world's most famous game reserve. Serengeti National Park, an area of grassy plains to the horizon, with countless ungulates and large groups of predators in their wake. to the horizon - with countless ungulates and large groups of predators in their wake - is famous for the great migration of more than a million wildebeest and zebra. Serengeti National Park is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and tops the list of Africa's most impressive safari parks.









Start your morning game drives and get up close to African predators and large herds of zebra, wildebeest and gazelle. After the game drive, Have enroute game drive as we drive to Seronera Airstrip for your flight to Zanzibar
